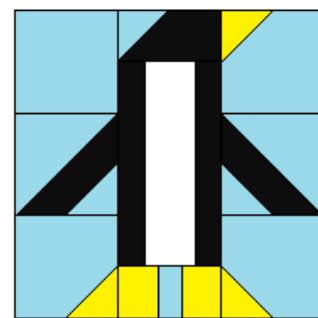
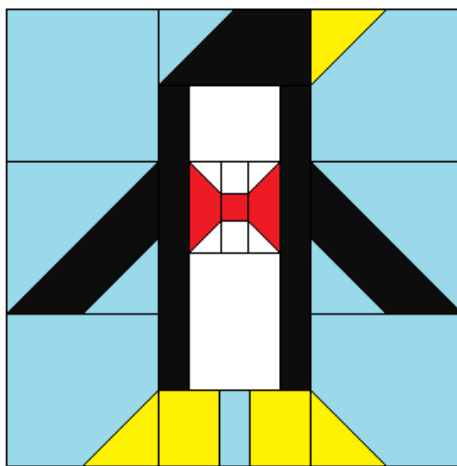


# Penguin Pyramid

12", 9" and 6" blocks

## Materials:

0.50 yard – Background Pale Blue  
 0.25 yard – Black  
 0.25 yard – White  
 0.25 yard – Yellow  
 0.25 yard – Red  
 0.25 yard – Binding  
 Batting and Backing to cover 18" x 33"

## Cutting Instructions:

From the **Background Pale Blue** cut:

1 @ 5" square, 4 @ 4.5" squares, 1 @ 4" square, 2 @ 3.5" x 6.5", 4 @ 3.5" squares, 1 @ 3" square,  
 7 @ 2.5" squares, 2 @ 2" x 9.5", 3 @ 2" squares, 1 @ 1.5" x 2.5", 3 @ 1.5" squares, 1 @ 1" x 2", 1 @ 1" x 1.5"

From the **Black** cut:

1 @ 5" square, 1 @ 4" square, 1 @ 3" square, 1 @ 2.5" x 4.5",  
 1 @ 2" x 3.5", 2 @ 1.5" x 8.5", 1 @ 1.5" x 2.5", 2 @ 1.25" x 6.5", 2 @ 1" x 4.5"

From the **White** cut:

1 @ 2.5" x 4.5", 1 @ 2.5" square, 1 @ 2" x 3.5", 1 @ 2" square,  
 4 @ 1.25" squares, 1 @ 1.5" x 4.5", 4 @ 1" x 1.25", 4 @ 1" squares

From the **Yellow** cut:

3 @ 2.5" squares, 2 @ 2" x 2.5", 3 @ 2" squares, 2 @ 1.75" x 2", 2 @ 1.25" x 1.5", 3 @ 1.5" squares

From the **Red** cut:

2 @ 1.25" x 2.5", 2 @ 1" x 2", 2 @ 1" squares

From the **Binding Fabric**:

Cut (2) 2.5" x WOF strips for binding. Prepare your binding and set aside for later.

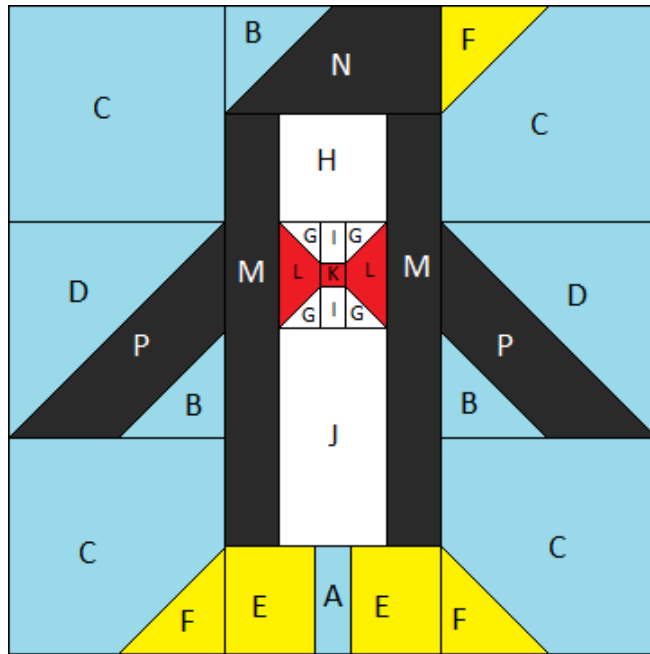

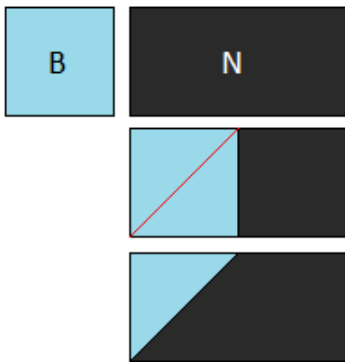
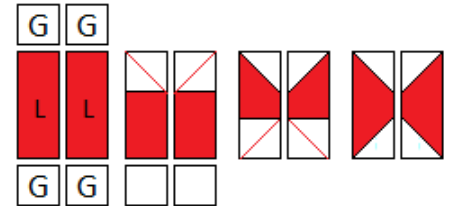

Finished Penguin Block will measure 12" square.

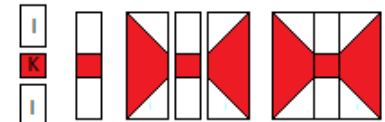


Background	A	1 @ 1.5" x 2.5"
	B	3 @ 2.5" squares
	C	4 @ 4.5" squares
	D	1 @ 5" square
Yellow	E	2 @ 2" x 2.5"
	F	3 @ 2.5" squares
White	G	4 @ 1.25" squares
	H	1 @ 2.5" square
	I	2 @ 1" x 1.25"
	J	1 @ 2.5" x 4.5"
Red	K	1 @ 1" square
	L	2 @ 1.25" x 2.5"
Black	M	2 @ 1.5" x 8.5"
	N	1 @ 2.5" x 4.5"
	P	1 @ 5" square

**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (G) squares. Place them on the ends of the (L) rectangles and sew along the diagonal lines, as shown in red. Trim a 1/4" seam and press open. Sew the (I) rectangles and (K) square together. Sewn the (IKI) unit between the (GLG) units.



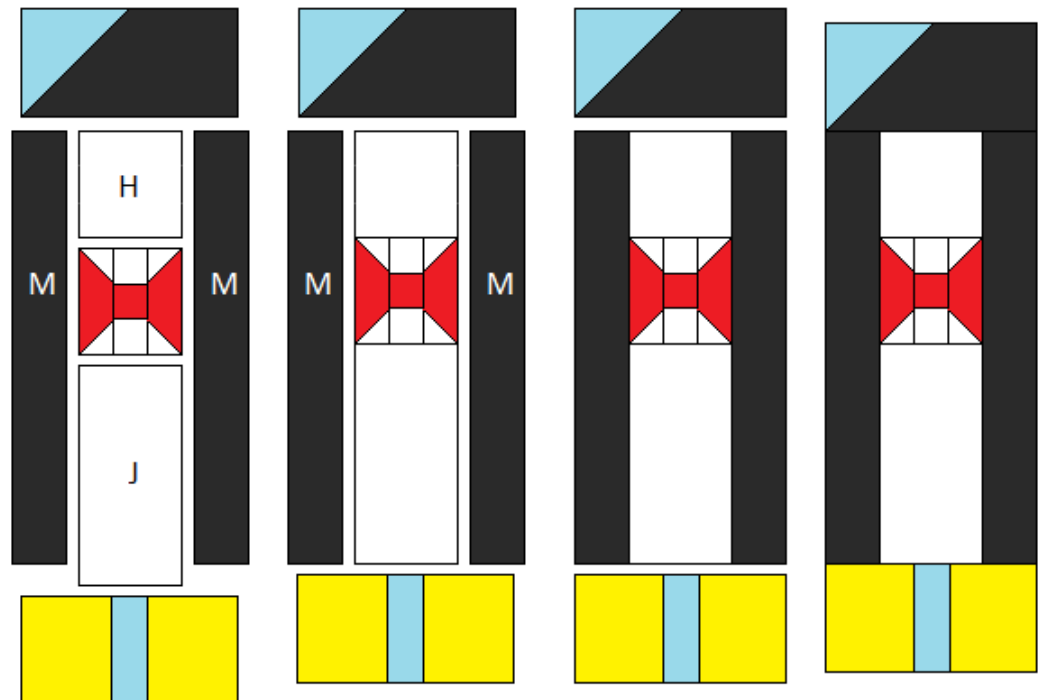
**Step 2:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (B) square. Place it on the end of the (N) rectangle and sew along the diagonal line, as shown in red. Trim a 1/4" seam and press open.



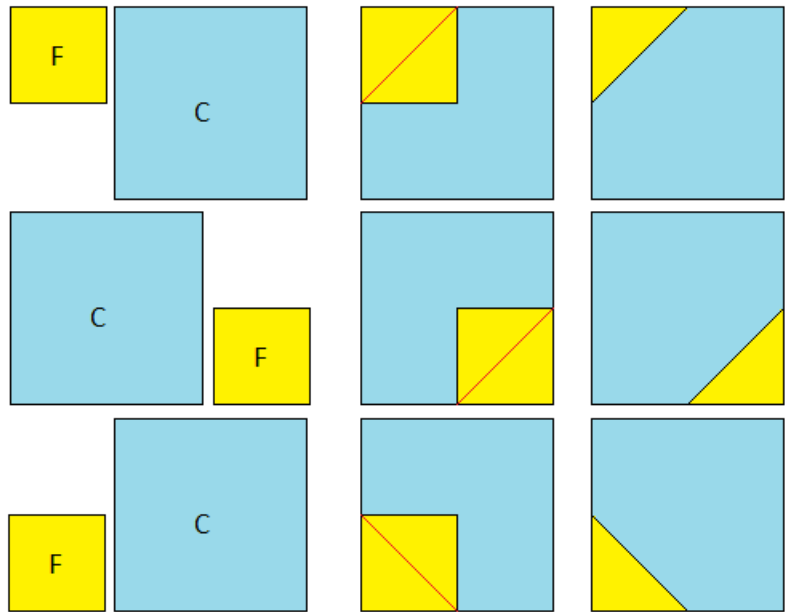
**Step 3:** Sew the (E) and (A) pieces together.



**Step 4:** Sew the (H) square on the top, and the (J) rectangle on the bottom, of the unit made in Step 1. Sew the (M) rectangles on the sides. Sew the (BN) unit on the top, and the (EAE) unit on the bottom.

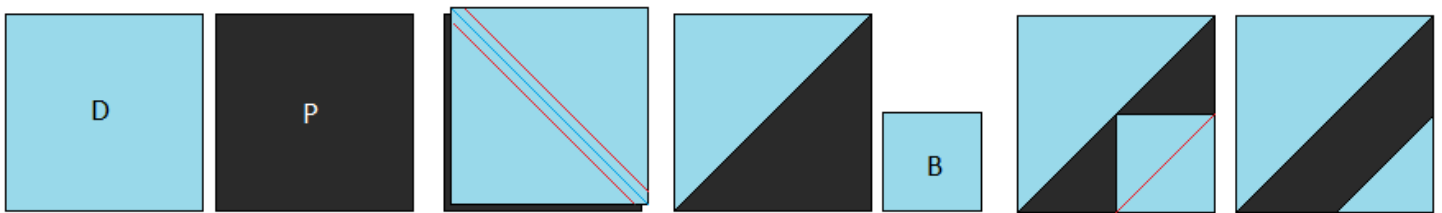


**Step 5:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (F) squares. Place them on the corners of the (C) squares and sew along the diagonal lines, as shown in red. Trim a ¼" seam and press open.

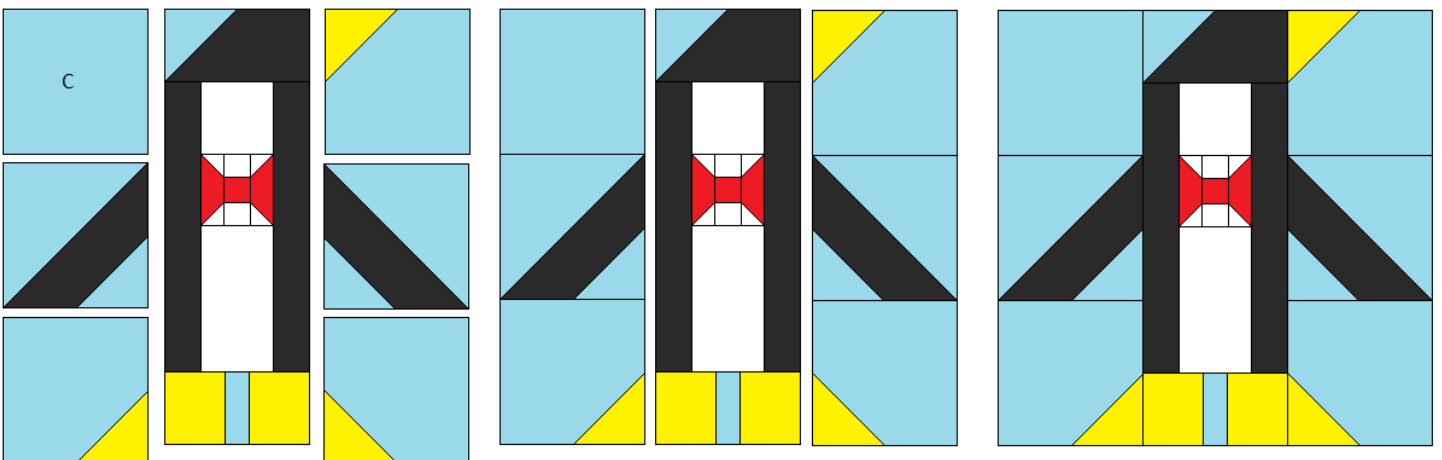


**Step 6:** Please note that the fabric squares should be 'sandwiched' with right sides facing together, and line up on all sides as accurately as possible. The diagram does not show this accuracy for demonstrative purposes. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (D) square. This is your **guide** line. Place the (D) square on the (P) square and sew a ¼" seam on EACH SIDE the blue line from edge to edge, as shown in red. Cut along the blue guide line.

Press the seams open and trim each of the resulting Half Square Triangles (HST) to 4.5". Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (B) squares. Place them on the corners of the HST squares and sew along the diagonal line, as shown in red. Trim a ¼" seam and press open. Make 2.



**Step 7:** Arrange the (C) square and the pieces made previously, as shown. Sew the side pieces together to make columns. Sew the side columns onto the center piece.

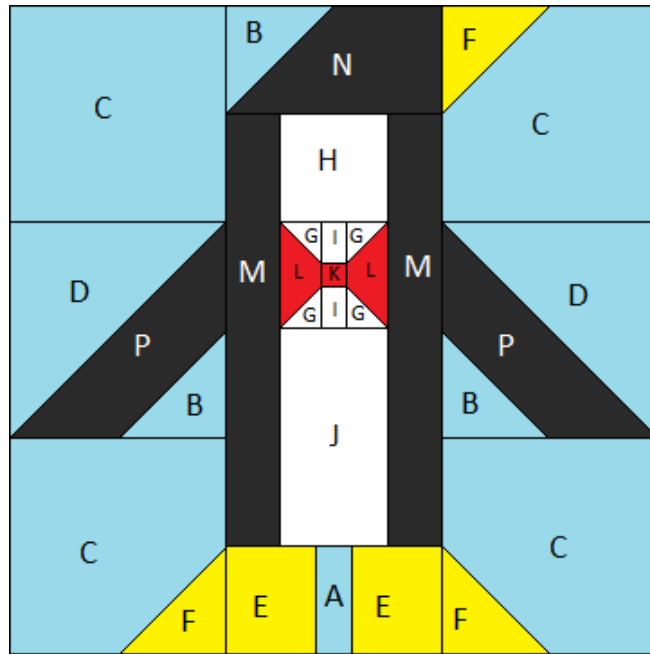

	D	1 @ 4" square
Yellow	E	2 @ 1.75" x 2"
	F	3 @ 2" squares
White	G	4 @ 1" squares
	H	1 @ 2" square
	I	2 @ 1" x 1.25"
	J	1 @ 2" x 3.5"
Red	K	1 @ 1" square
	L	2 @ 1" x 2"
Black	M	2 @ 1.25" x 6.5"
	N	1 @ 2" x 3.5"
	P	1 @ 4" square

**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (G) squares. Place them on the ends of the (L) rectangles and sew along the diagonal lines, as shown in red. Trim a 1/4" seam and press open. Sew the (I) rectangles and (K) square together. Sewn the (IKI) unit between the (GLG) units.



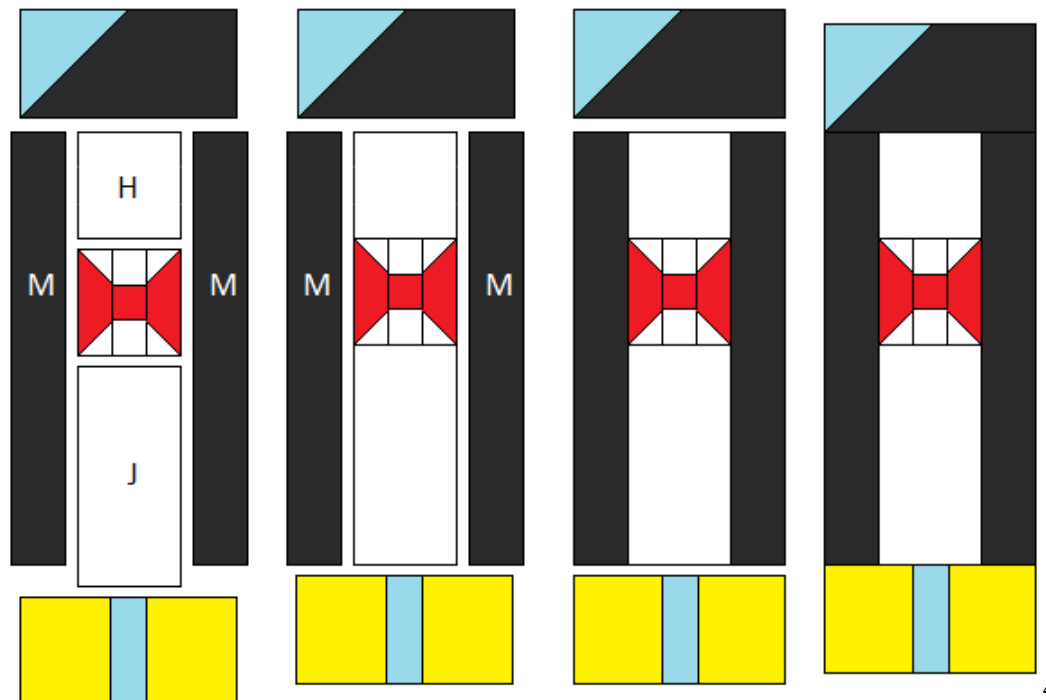
**Step 2:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (B) square. Place it on the end of the (N) rectangle and sew along the diagonal line, as shown in red. Trim a 1/4" seam and press open.



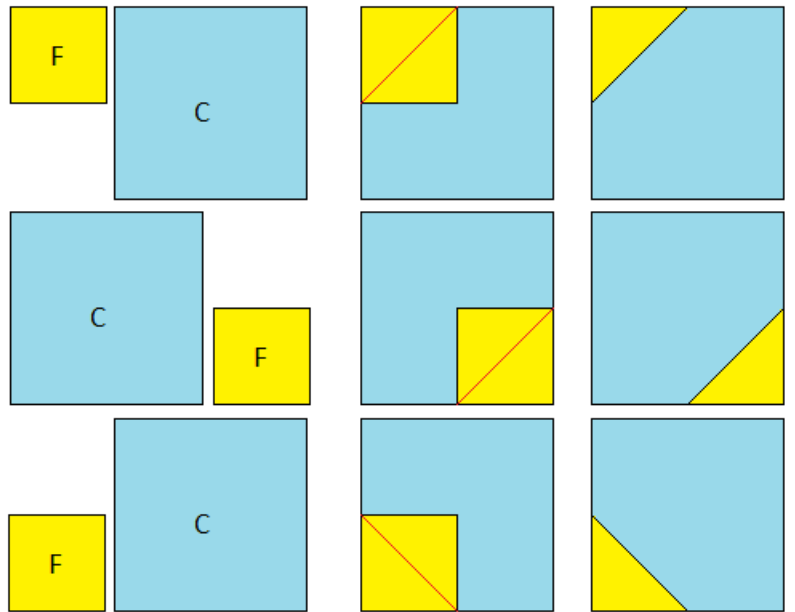
**Step 3:** Sew the (E) and (A) pieces together.



**Step 4:** Sew the (H) square on the top, and the (J) rectangle on the bottom, of the unit made in Step 1. Sew the (M) rectangles on the sides. Sew the (BN) unit on the top, and the (EAE) unit on the bottom.

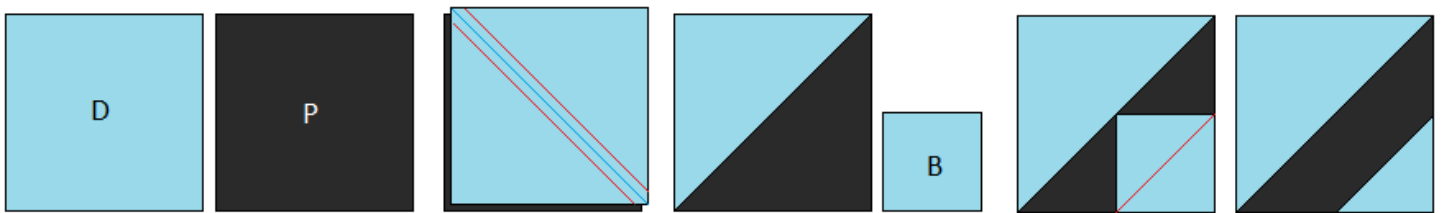


**Step 5:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (F) squares. Place them on the corners of the (C) squares and sew along the diagonal lines, as shown in red. Trim a ¼" seam and press open.

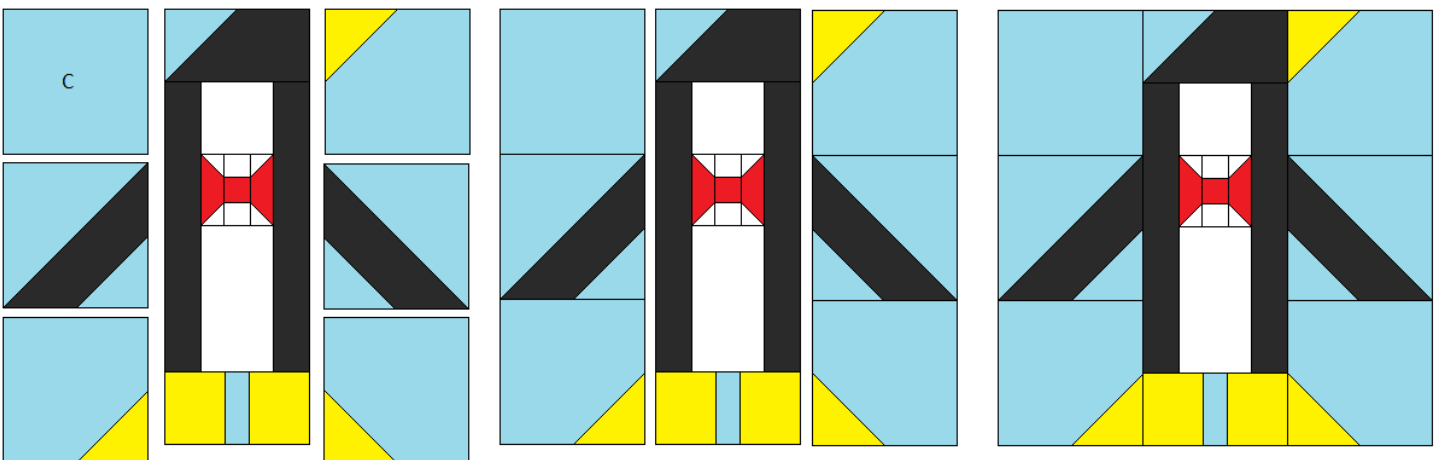


**Step 6:** Please note that the fabric squares should be 'sandwiched' with right sides facing together, and line up on all sides as accurately as possible. The diagram does not show this accuracy for demonstrative purposes. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (D) square. This is your **guide** line. Place the (D) square on the (P) square and sew a ¼" seam on EACH SIDE the blue line from edge to edge, as shown in red. Cut along the blue guide line.

Press the seams open and trim each of the resulting Half Square Triangles (HST) to 3.5". Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (B) squares. Place them on the corners of the HST squares and sew along the diagonal line, as shown in red. Trim a ¼" seam and press open. Make 2.



**Step 7:** Arrange the (C) square and the pieces made previously, as shown. Sew the side pieces together to make columns. Sew the side columns onto the center piece.

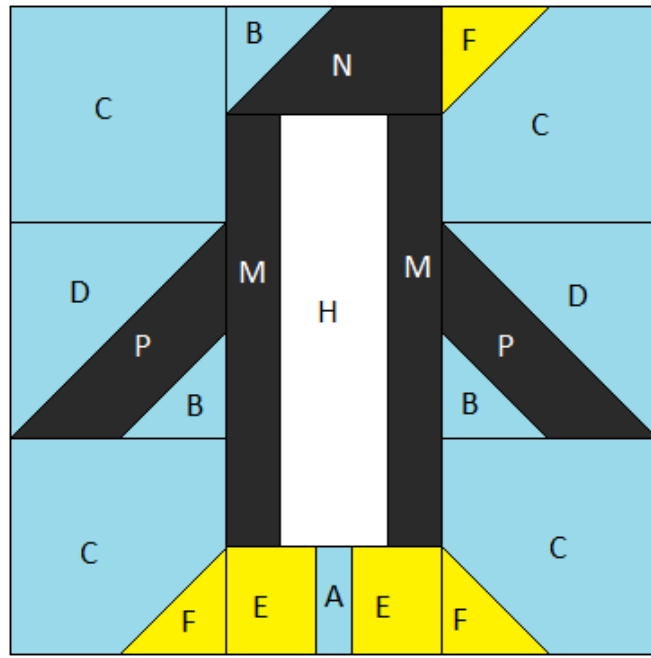

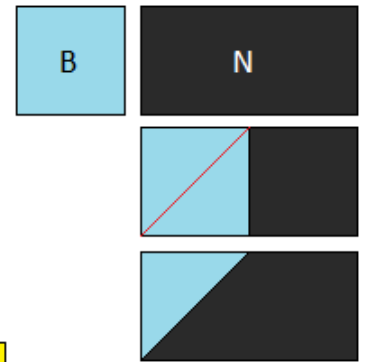

Background	A	1 @ 1" x 1.5"
	B	3 @ 1.5" squares
	C	4 @ 2.5" squares
	D	1 @ 3" square
Yellow	E	2 @ 1.5" x 1.25"
	F	3 @ 1.5" squares
White	H	1 @ 1.5" x 4.5"
Black	M	2 @ 1" x 4.5"
	N	1 @ 1.5" x 2.5"
	P	1 @ 3" square

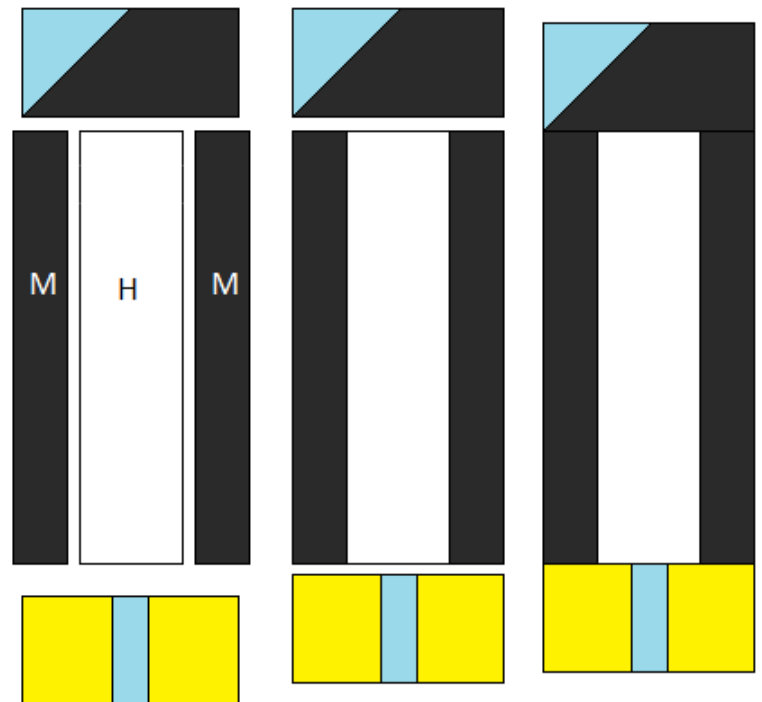


**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (B) square. Place it on the end of the (N) rectangle and sew along the diagonal line, as shown in red. Trim a 1/4" seam and press open.

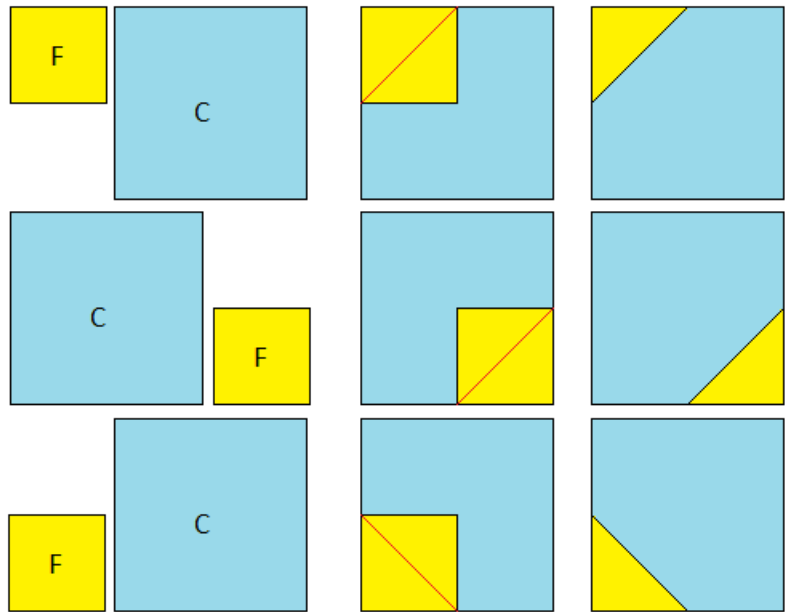


**Step 2:** Sew the (E) and (A) pieces together.

**Step 3:** Sew the (M) rectangles on the sides of the (H) rectangle. Sew the (BN) unit on the top, and the (EAE) unit on the bottom.

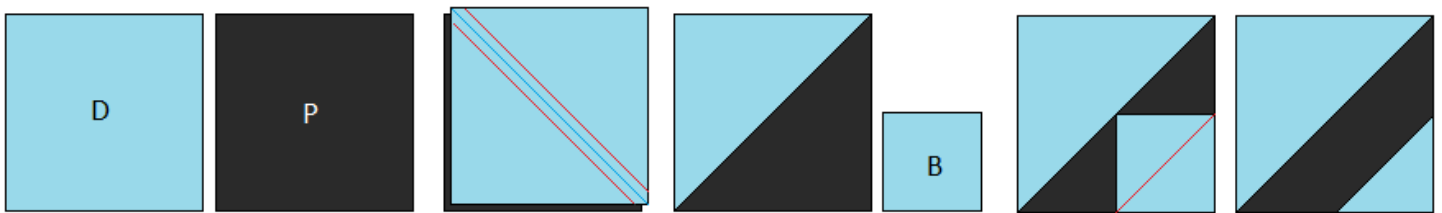


**Step 4:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (F) squares. Place them on the corners of the (C) squares and sew along the diagonal lines, as shown in red. Trim a ¼" seam and press open.

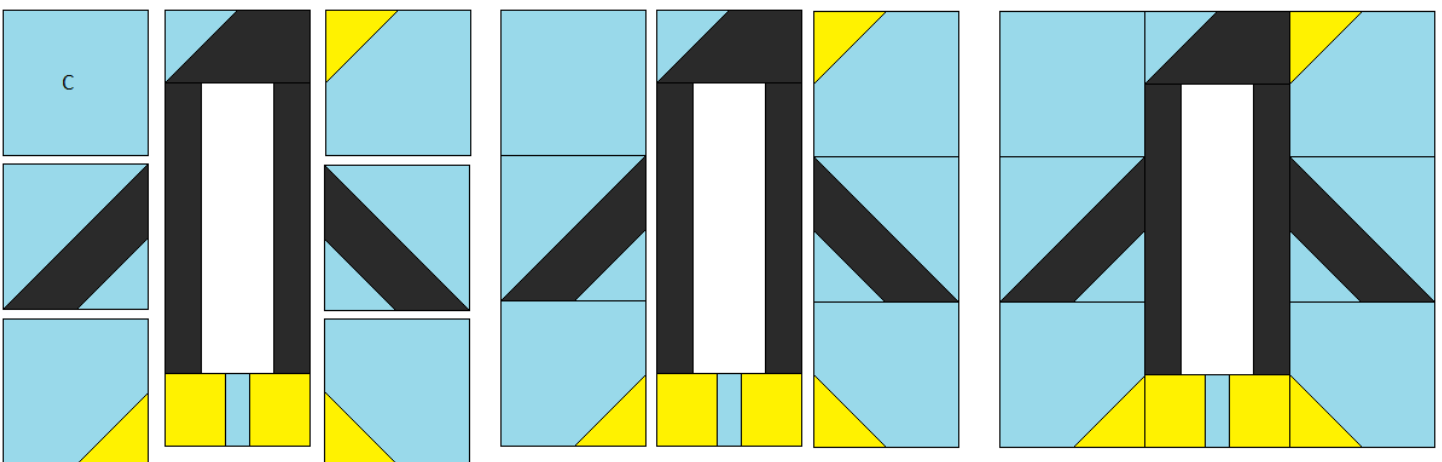


**Step 5:** Please note that the fabric squares should be 'sandwiched' with right sides facing together, and line up on all sides as accurately as possible. The diagram does not show this accuracy for demonstrative purposes. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (D) square. This is your **guide** line. **Step 6:** Arrange the (C) square and the pieces made previously, as shown. Sew the side pieces together to make columns. Sew the side columns onto the center piece.



# Penguin Wallhanging

## Assembly Instructions:

**Step 1:** Sew the Background 2" x 9.5" strips to the sides of the 9" Penguin block. Sew the Background 3.5" x 6.5" strips to the sides of the 6" Penguin block.

**Step 2:** Sew the rows together.

**Step 3:** Prepare your backing and batting. Baste the quilt. And quilt as desired. Trim and bind your quilt.
