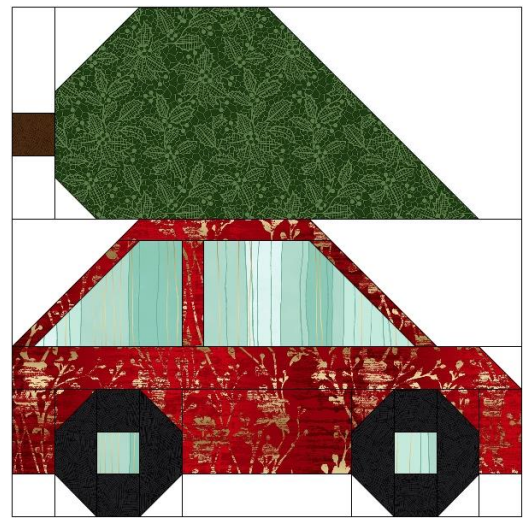


Sew Fresh Quilts – Christmas Quilt Block – Car and Christmas Tree

	A	6 @ 1.5" square
	G	1 @ 1.5" x 2"
	E	1 @ 1.5" x 3"
	D	1 @ 2.5" square
	L	1 @ 3.5" square
	M	1 @ 3.5" x 5.5"
	N	1 @ 5.5" x 6.5"
Car	*	1 @ 1" x 3"
	**	1 @ 1" x 10.5"
	A	4 @ 1.5" square
	F	1 @ 1.5" x 12.5"
	#	1 @ 2.5" x 8"
	H	2 @ 3" x 3.5"
Black	@	2 @ 1.5" x 4"
	C	4 @ 1.5" x 3.5"

Fabric Require	Single Block
Background	1/4 yard
Green	1/8 yard
Red	1/8 yard
Window	1/8 yard
Black	1/8 yard
Brown	1/8 yard

Finished size of block is 12" x 12"



Piecing methods explained:

STOP: Stitch, Trim, Open & Press.

1. Align square (A) on top of unit (B), with right sides together.

2. Draw a diagonal line, as shown in red.

3. Sew along diagonal line. Trim 1/4" seam.

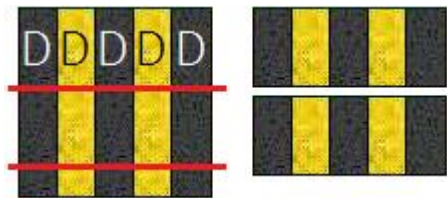
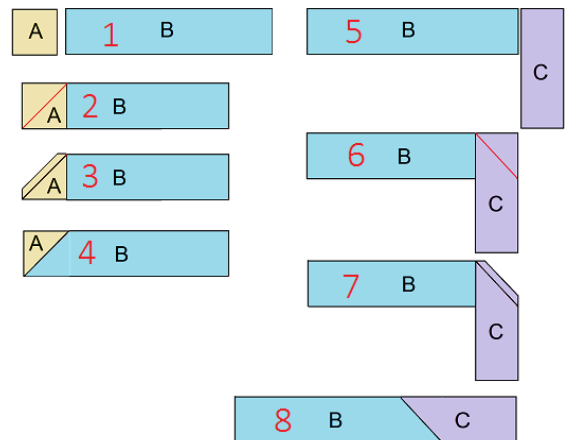
4. Finger press seam open then press with a hot iron.

5. Align rectangle (C) on unit (B), with right sides together.

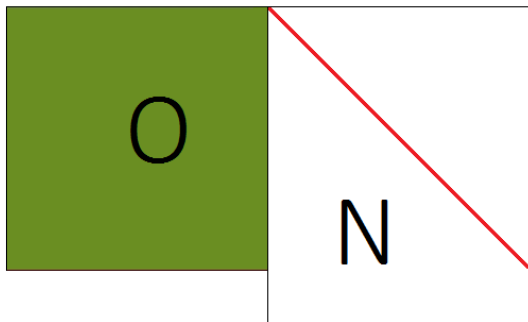
6. Draw a diagonal line, as shown in red.

7. Sew along diagonal line. Trim 1/4" seam.

8. Finger press seam open then press with a hot iron.



STRIP PIECING. Sew strips together along length and press seams open. Trim end square and then crosscut strip set into widths, as shown in red, according to the size indicated in the instructions.



Read through entire instructions before beginning.

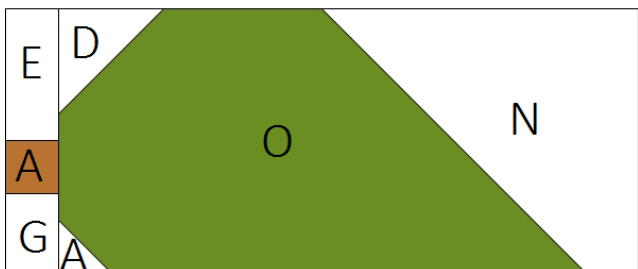
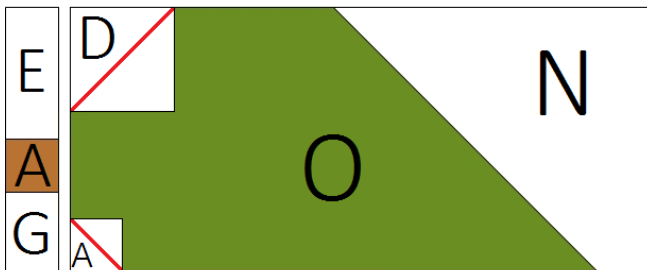
Cutting Chart includes seam allowances. Cut to size listed in chart.

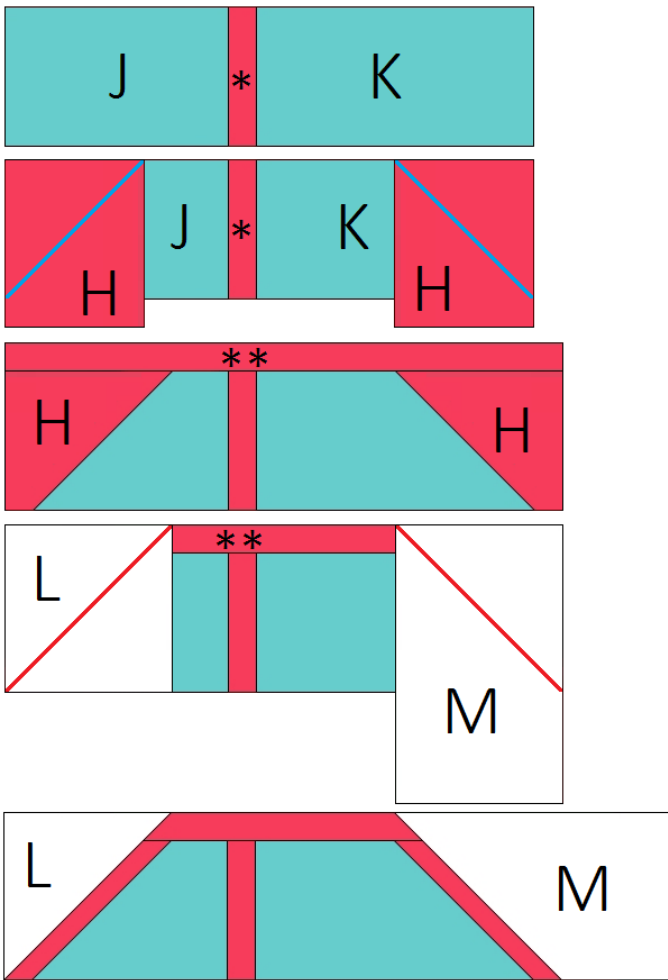
Use 1/4" seam for piecing. Press seams open as you go, to reduce bulk.

Step 1: Use STOP method to add Background (N) to Green (O), then to add Background (D) and (A) = TOP

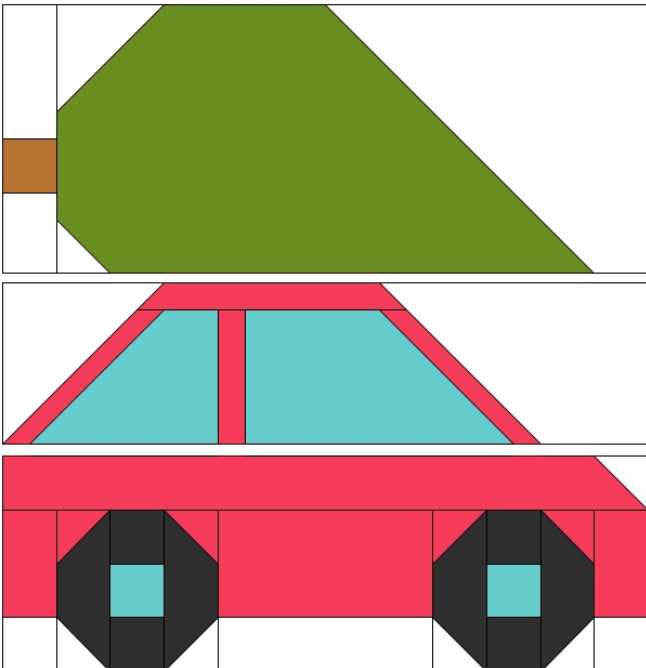
Sew Brown (A) between Background (E) and (G) = TRUNK

Sew TRUNK on end of TOP = TREE





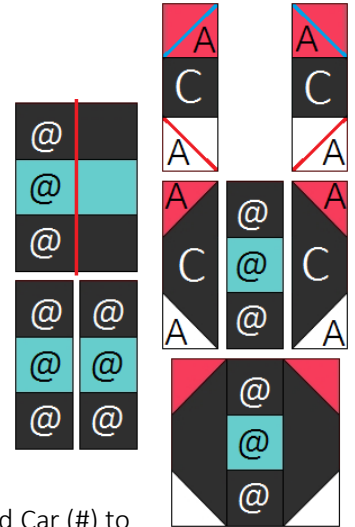
Step 5: Sew ROOF between TREE and WHEELS to complete.
Block should measure 12.5" square



Step 2: Sew Car (*) between Window (J) and (K), then use STOP method to add Car (H) to each end. Sew Car (**) on top, then use STOP method to add Background (L) and (M) = ROOF

Step 3: Use STRIP PIECING method to add Window (@) between Black (@), then crosscut into 1.5" strips = RIMS

Use STOP method to add Car (A) and Background (A) to Black (C), then sew RIMS between = TIRES
Make 2



Step 4: Use STRIP PIECING method to add Car (#) to Background (?), then crosscut into 1 @ 4.5" wide = DOOR and 2 @ 1.5" strips = FENDERS

Sew TIRES between FENDERS and DOOR = BOTTOM
Use STOP method to add Background (A) to Car (F) = BODYLINE
Sew BODYLINE above BOTTOM = WHEELS

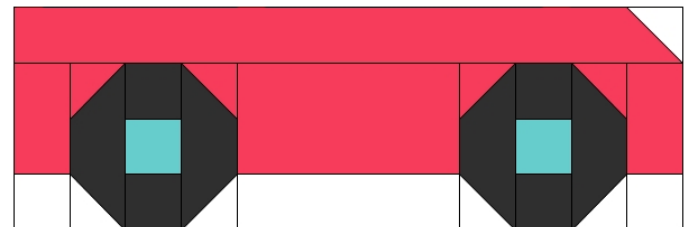
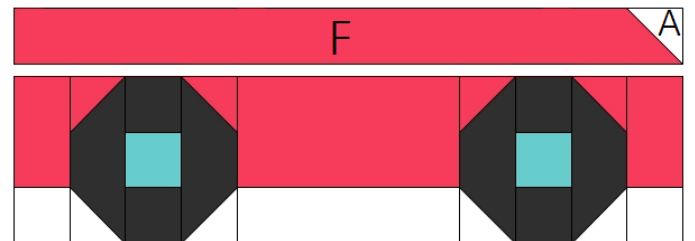
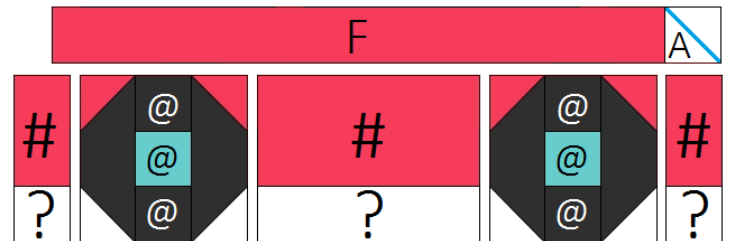
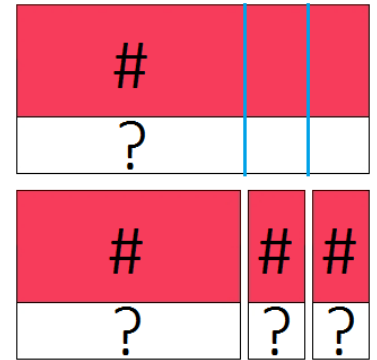


Table Runner finishes 16" x 42" using 1.5" wide sashing between blocks and 2.5" wide for borders.



Quilt finishes 55" x 68" using Poinsettia blocks and 1.5" wide sashing between blocks and rows, and 2.5" wide for borders.
